Purposes in its constitution	Educational and recreational charity. "Library" is specifically included.	Educational and recreational charity. "Library" is not mentioned. "Community Hub" is specified instead.
Basic Structure	Democratic	Paternalistic
Organisation Type	Association with a membership.	Foundation. Its constitution prohibits it from having members other than its trustees.
Run by	Trustees appointed by members at AGMs.	Trustees appointed by a majority of the five individuals, who have appointed themselves, and subsequently appointed trustees.
Meetings to inform the community	Open to anyone.	Open only to Associate Members of the Trust. Its constitution specifies that these are non-voting and not to be regarded as members for any purpose of the Charities legislation.
